COMMITTEE AMENDMENT "A" to H.P. 201, L.D. 239, Bill, "An Act To Provide a Felony Penalty for Assault on a Firefighter"

Amend the bill in section 1 in §752-E in subsection 1 in the 3rd line (page 1, line 6 in L.D.) by inserting after the following: "duties" the following: 'at the scene of a fire or other emergency'

SUMMARY

This amendment is the majority report of the Criminal Justice and Public Safety Committee. The amendment specifies that the Class C assault on a firefighter applies only in situations where the firefighter is performing official duties at the scene of a fire or other emergency.
