9 SENATE AMENDMENT "A" to S.P. 85, L.D. 248, "Resolve, Honoring Women Veterans of Maine"

10 Amend the resolve by striking out everything after the emergency preamble and
11 before the emergency clause and inserting the following:

12 **Sec. 1. Bureau of General Services to establish account to accept funds**
13 **for construction of a monument honoring women veterans of Maine.**
14 **Resolved:** That the Director of the Bureau of General Services within the Department
15 of Administrative and Financial Services shall establish an account to accept donations
16 for the Women Veterans Monument as recommended by the Commission to Arrange for
17 a Monument Honoring Women Veterans of Maine; and be it further

18 **Sec. 2. Transfer of funds; General Fund unappropriated surplus to**
19 **Buildings and Grounds Operations, Other Special Revenue Funds account.**
20 **Resolved:** That, notwithstanding any other provisions of law, by June 30, 2008, the
21 State Controller shall transfer \$10,000 from General Fund unappropriated surplus to the
22 Buildings and Grounds Operations, Other Special Revenue Funds account within the
23 Department of Administrative and Financial Services; and be it further

24 **Sec. 3. Appropriations and allocations. Resolved:** That the following
25 appropriations and allocations are made.


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SUMMARY

Fiscal Detail and Notes

This amendment removes the General Fund appropriation of \$250,000 in fiscal year 2006-07 and provides a transfer of \$10,000 in fiscal year 2007-08 from the General Fund unappropriated surplus to the Other Special Revenue Funds account, Buildings and Grounds Operations within the Department of Administrative and Financial Services. It also includes an Other Special Revenue Funds allocation of \$10,000 in fiscal year 2007-08 to provide funding for the construction of a monument to honor women veterans of Maine.
