COMMITTEE AMENDMENT "A" to S.P. 86, L.D. 249, Bill, "An Act To Establish
May as Missing Persons Month"

Amend the bill by striking out the title and substituting the following:

'An Act To Establish May 25th as Missing Persons Day'

Amend the bill by striking out all of section 1 and inserting the following:

'Sec. 1. 1 MRSA §150 is enacted to read:

§150. Missing Persons Day

The Governor shall annually issue a proclamation establishing May 25th as Missing
Persons Day. The proclamation must invite and urge citizens, law enforcement agencies,
family service agencies and other suitable organizations and groups to observe this day
through appropriate activities.'

SUMMARY

This amendment establishes May 25th as Missing Persons Day. The bill had
established May as Missing Persons Month.
