1	Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine as follows:
2	Sec. 1. 12 MRSA §10105, sub-§1-A is enacted to read:
3	1-A. Authorize taking and destruction of fish. Whenever an illegal introduction
4	of invasive fish species occurs and the commissioner determines it necessary for resource
5	protection and management, the commissioner may authorize licensed anglers to assist
6	the commissioner in the taking and destruction of that invasive fish species.
7	SUMMARY
8	This bill allows the Commissioner of Inland Fisheries and Wildlife, when an illegal
9	introduction of invasive fish species has occurred, to authorize licensed anglers to assist
10	in the taking and destruction of that invasive fish species.
