1	Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine as follows:
2	Sec. 1. 29-A MRSA §501, sub-§7, ¶A, as enacted by PL 1993, c. 683, Pt. A, §2 and affected by Pt. B, §5, is amended to read:
4 5 6	A. A temporary registration permit is for one trip only, between the points of origin and destination and intermediate points set forth in the permit, or one round trip only, from the point of origin to a temporary destination and back to the point of origin.

SUMMARY

This bill allows the use of a temporary registration permit, which currently may be used only for a one-way trip, to be used for a round trip, as long as the entire trip occurs within 15 days. The purpose of this change, for example, is to allow a vehicle to be transported from a dealer to a garage and back to the dealer.
