1 **Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine as follows:**

2 **Sec. 1. 12 MRSA §10352, sub-§2**, as enacted by PL 2003, c. 414, Pt. A, §2 and
3 affected by c. 614, §9, is amended to read:

4 **2. Compensation.** The compensation of the wardens appointed pursuant to section
5 10351, subsection 1 is determined under the Civil Service Law. Assistant game wardens
6 appointed pursuant to section 10351, subsection 2 are not entitled to compensation but, at
7 the discretion of the Game Warden Colonel and approval of the commissioner, may be
8 compensated for mandatory assignments and for attendance at mandatory training or
9 other required meetings or classes and reimbursed for approved expenses.

SUMMARY

11 This bill authorizes the Department of Inland Fisheries and Wildlife, Bureau of
12 Warden Service to compensate assistant game wardens for mandatory assignments and
13 their attendance at mandatory training, classes or meetings and reimburse assistant game
14 wardens for approved expenses.
