1	Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine as follows:
2	Sec. 1. 7 MRSA §3909-A is enacted to read:
3	§3909-A. Immunity from civil liability
4 5 6	1. Immunity. A licensed veterinarian who performs any animal welfare service at the request of the State or a state agency is immune from any civil liability arising from that service if:
7 8	A. The service is within the scope of that veterinarian's licensure; and B. The veterinarian acts in good faith.
9 10	2. Exception. The immunity provided by this section is not available if the veterinarian acted recklessly or with gross negligence.
11	SUMMARY
12 13	This bill provides immunity from civil suit for any veterinarian who performs animal welfare services for the State.
