Whereas, acts and resolves of the Legislature do not 14 become effective until 90 days after adjournment unless enacted as emergencies; and 15 Whereas, Public Law 2005, chapter 597 takes effect July 1, 2007, which is prior to the expiration of the 90-day period; and 16 17 Whereas, Public Law 2005, chapter 597 provides that local rate of growth 18 ordinances must be based upon the number of building or development permits issued 19 over the past 10 years; and Whereas, the current language could be interpreted to mean all building permits, 20 21 including permits for minor construction, and not just new residential dwellings; and 22 Whereas, in the judgment of the Legislature, these facts create an emergency within 23 the meaning of the Constitution of Maine and require the following legislation as immediately necessary for the preservation of the public peace, health and safety; now, 24 25 therefore,' 26 Amend the bill by adding before the summary the following: 27 'Emergency clause. In view of the emergency cited in the preamble, this legislation takes effect when approved.' 28

29 **SUMMARY**

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This amendment adds an emergency preamble and emergency clause to the bill.

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
