3 4	Y. An amount equal to contributions deductible under section 530 of the Code made by an employer to a Coverdell education savings account of a child of an employee.
5 6	Sec. 2. Application. This Act applies to tax years beginning on or after January 1, 2007.

8 9	This bill provides an income tax deduction for contributions made by employers to a Coverdell education savings account of a child of an employee.
