| 8 | 2. County jail medication formularies. Beginning January 1, 2008, the |
| 9 | commissioners of each county shall adopt for the county jail a medication formulary |
| 10 | The medication formulary must include the same medications for mental illness and |
| 11 | mental conditions as are listed on the medication formulary at the Maine State Prisor |

| 14 | This bill requires the Commissioner of Corrections to notify the county |
| 15 | commissioners of the medications for mental illness and mental conditions included or |
| 16 | the medication formulary of the Maine State Prison and requires the county jails to have |
