1	Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine as follows:
2	Sec. 1. 29-A MRSA §2396, sub-§5 is enacted to read:
3 4	5. Poultry fecal matter. A person may not operate on a public way a vehicle with a load of poultry fecal matter that is not covered.
5	SUMMARY
6 7	This bill requires that a motor vehicle hauling a load of poultry fecal matter be covered.
