- Sec. 1. 29-A MRSA §2116 is enacted to read:
- 3 §2116. Funeral processions
- A person operating a motor vehicle may not interrupt or cut into a funeral procession.
- 5 A violation of this section is a traffic infraction for which a fine not to exceed \$100 may
- 6 <u>be adjudged.</u>
