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Sec. 1. 20-A MRSA §13007, sub-§1, as amended by PL 2005, c. 457, Pt. FF, §1,
 is repealed.

4 Sec. 2. 20-A MRSA §13023, sub-§6, as enacted by PL 2005, c. 457, Pt. FF, §2,
 5 is repealed.

SUMMARY

In the First Regular Session of the 122nd Legislature, new certification and
authorization fees were established to help balance the Department of Education's
budget. This bill repeals those charges that were imposed on school employees for their
certifications and authorizations.
