13 **SUMMARY**

14 This bill makes a one-time General Fund appropriation of \$300,000 in fiscal year
15 2007-08 to provide funding for the Maine Drug Enforcement Agency to establish a pilot
16 program for return of unused prescription drugs by mail consistent with the
17 recommendations of the Maine Drug Return Implementation Group established in Public
18 Law 2003, chapter 679.
