An Act To Reform the Dirigo Health Program

1 Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine as follows:

2 3	CONCEPT DRAFT SUMMARY
4	This bill is a concept draft pursuant to Joint Rule 208.
5 6	This bill proposes to make the following changes to the laws governing health insurance and the Dirigo Health program:
7 8 9	1. It would require that, rather than contracting out for health insurance services, Dirigo Health offer health insurance provided by a private health insurance company that would be modeled on Maine Employers' Mutual Insurance Company;
10 11	2. It would require that premiums for health insurance under Dirigo Health be set at 5% of the individual's income;
12	3. It would repeal guaranteed issue requirements;
13	4. It would create a high-risk pool;
14	5. It would establish a schedule of required copayments for health care services;
15	6. It would repeal all state-mandated health insurance coverage;
16 17	7. It would require the Executive Director of Dirigo Health to maximize use of Medicaid funds;
18	8. It would ensure portability of health insurance policies; and
19	9. It would provide that payments for health insurance be tax deductible.

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
