9 10 11	COMMITTEE AMENDMENT " A " to S.P. 142, L.D. 441, Bill, "An Act To Restructure the Board of Commissioners of the Maine State Housing Authority To Closely Match Local Authorities"

12 Amend the bill by striking out everything after the title and before the summary and 13 inserting in its place the following:

14 'Emergency preamble. Whereas, acts and resolves of the Legislature do not become effective until 90 days after adjournment unless enacted as emergencies; and 15

Whereas, it is necessary to improve and restore confidence in the governance of the 16 Board of Commissioners of the Maine State Housing Authority to allow for greater 17 responsiveness to and representation of the people it serves; and 18

19 Whereas, in the judgment of the Legislature, these facts create an emergency within 20 the meaning of the Constitution of Maine and require the following legislation as 21 immediately necessary for the preservation of the public peace, health and safety; now, 22 therefore,

23 Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine as follows:

24 Sec. 1. 30-A MRSA §4723, sub-§2, ¶B, as enacted by PL 1987, c. 737, Pt. A, §2 25 and Pt. C, §106 and amended by PL 1989, c. 6; c. 9, §2; and c. 104, Pt. C, §§8 and 10, is further amended to read: 26

27 B. The Maine State Housing Authority, as authorized by Title 5, chapter 379, shall 28 must have $7 \, 10$ commissioners, $5 \, 8$ of whom shall must be appointed by the 29 Governor, subject to review by the joint standing committee of the Legislature having 30 jurisdiction over economic development, and to confirmation by the Legislature. The 31 6th 9th commissioner is the Treasurer of State who shall serve serves as an ex officio 32 voting member. The Treasurer of State may designate the Deputy Treasurer of State 33 to serve in place of the Treasurer of State. The 7th 10th commissioner is the director 34 of the Maine State Housing Authority who shall serve serves as an ex officio, and 35 who is chairman of the commissioners nonvoting member. The 5 At least 3

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1 gubernatorial appointments must include, but are not limited to, representatives a 2 representative of bankers and of low-income or, a representative of elderly people-3 One commissioner must be and a resident of housing which that is subsidized or 4 assisted by programs of the United States Department of Housing and Urban 5 Development or of the Maine State Housing Authority. In making this appointment 6 appointing the resident. the Governor shall give priority consideration to 7 nominations that may be made by tenant associations established in the State. Of the 8 5 remaining gubernatorial appointments, the Governor shall give priority to a 9 representative involved in the housing business and a representative of people with 10 disabilities. 11 The Governor shall appoint the chair of the commissioners from among the 8 12 gubernatorial appointments. The chair serves as a nonvoting member, except that the 13 chair may vote only to break a tie. The commissioners shall elect a vice-chairman 14 vice-chair of the commissioners from among their number. The commissioners of 15 the Maine State Housing Authority shall establish and revise from time to time 16 policies of the Maine State Housing Authority relating to the following particular 17 matters: 18 (1) Standards of issuing, servicing and redeeming bonds; 19 (2) Purchase, sale or commitment to purchase mortgages or notes; 20 (3) Initiating project construction and accepting properly completed facilities; 21 (4) Setting and establishing selection and evaluation standards, criteria and 22 procedures under which it will purchase, sell or agree to purchase loans, notes or 23 obligations, having regard among other things to: (a) Property values; 24 25 (b) Local economic conditions and expectancy; 26 (c) Credit and employment; and 27 (d) Local housing conditions and needs and the availability of credit 28 resources to meet those needs relative to similar or competing conditions and 29 needs in other localities in the State: 30 (5) Setting and establishing procedures for the servicing of loans, notes and obligations acquired by it, including the allowance of servicing fees to 31 32 participating lenders to whom the Maine State Housing Authority may entrust 33 such servicing; 34 (6) Setting and establishing procedures for the collection of money due from

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(6) Setting and establishing procedures for the collection of money due from
persons liable for payment, as to any loan, note or obligation held by the Maine
State Housing Authority, by subrogation or otherwise, and to initiate and
maintain any action at law or in equity, including foreclosure proceedings, to
enforce payment;

39 (7) Setting and establishing procedures for the orderly liquidation and
40 disposition of any property acquired by the Maine State Housing Authority

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through foreclosure or otherwise in full or partial satisfaction of any debt or obligation held by it; and

(8) Establishing and maintaining out of income or otherwise any reserves that the Maine State Housing Authority from time to time determines to be necessary and prudent in addition to those specifically required.

6 Following reasonable notice to each commissioner, 4-5 commissioners of the Maine 7 State Housing Authority constitute a quorum for the purpose of conducting its 8 business, exercising its powers and for all other purposes, notwithstanding the 9 existence of any vacancies. Action may be taken by the commissioners upon a vote 10 of a majority of the commissioners present, unless its bylaws require a larger number.

11 Sec. 2. Transition provisions; completion date. All appointments to the 12 Board of Commissioners of the Maine State Housing Authority must be completed by 13 January 31, 2008. The following provisions govern the transition in appointments of 14 board members and changes to the board pursuant to the Maine Revised Statutes, Title 15 30-A, section 4723, subsection 2, paragraph B.

16 1. In making the 3 new appointments, the Governor must give priority to a 17 representative involved in the housing business and a representative of people with 18 disabilities. The members currently serving on the board continue to serve until the 19 expiration of their terms. Thereafter, the commissioners must be appointed as provided 20 in the Maine Revised Statutes, Title 30-A, section 4723, subsection 2, paragraph B.

2. The director of the Maine State Housing Authority shall serve as chair of the
board of commissioners until a successor is appointed.

3. Four commissioners constitute a quorum until all gubernatorial appointees have
been confirmed.

Emergency clause. In view of the emergency cited in the preamble, this legislation takes effect when approved.'

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SUMMARY

28 This amendment adds an emergency preamble and clause and replaces the bill. It 29 increases the number of commissioners on the Maine State Housing Authority from 7 to 30 10 commissioners, increases the number appointed by the Governor from 5 to 8 and 31 requires that at least 3 appointments be given to a representative of bankers, the elderly 32 and a resident of subsidized housing. It requires that of the 5 remaining gubernatorial 33 appointments, priority be given to a representative involved in the housing business and a 34 representative of the disability community. It requires that the director of the Maine State 35 Housing Authority serve as an exofficio, nonvoting member and the Treasurer of State 36 serve as an exofficio voting member. It requires the Governor to appoint the chair of the

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- 1 commissioners from among the 8 gubernatorial appointments and provides that the chair
- 2 serve as a nonvoting member, except that the chair may vote only to break a tie. It also
- 3 increases the number of commissioners necessary for a quorum from 4 to 5.
