4 This bill is a concept draft pursuant to Joint Rule 208.

5 This bill proposes to fashion an approach to make creative space more available and  
6 more affordable. Under this bill, the Maine Arts Commission would work in concert with  
7 groups of individuals involved in similar creative media, disciplines or arts to keep costs  
8 down and enhance creativity and economic stability for those individuals.
