4 This bill is a concept draft pursuant to Joint Rule 208.

5 This bill proposes to clarify the definition of an all-terrain vehicle in the statutes and
6 further proposes to enact restrictions on the use of all-terrain vehicle trails, including
7 limiting truck use on the trails designed for all-terrain vehicle use.
