COMMITTEE AMENDMENT "A" to S.P. 162, L.D. 475, Bill, "An Act To Prevent Additional Housing Charges for Persons Requiring In-home Care"

Amend the bill in section 1 in §7309 in the first paragraph in the last line (page 1, line 5 in L.D.) by inserting after the following: "tenant." the following: 'A landlord may request a letter from the Department of Health and Human Services to verify a tenant's eligibility for the use of in-home or community support services. This section is repealed January 1, 2009.'

**SUMMARY**

This amendment provides that a landlord may request a letter from the Department of Health and Human Services to verify that a tenant is eligible for the use of in-home or community support services. This amendment also adds a provision to repeal the section of law enacted in this legislation effective January 1, 2009.
