1 **Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine as follows:**

2 **Sec. 1. 32 MRSA §2403, first ¶**, as amended by PL 1983, c. 553, §38, is further  
3 amended to read:

4 Applicants for a master or journeyman's oil burner technician or master solid fuel  
5 burner technician license shall present to the board a written application for examination,  
6 containing such information as the board may require, accompanied by the prescribed fee.  
7 Examinations ~~shall~~ must be in whole or in part in writing, ~~shall~~ must be conducted by the  
8 board and ~~shall~~ must be of a thorough and practical character commensurate with the  
9 responsibilities of the type of license applied for. The board shall provide at least one  
10 examination site per county and provide for an applicant to take an examination online.

11 **SUMMARY**

12 This bill requires the Oil and Solid Fuel Board to provide at least one license  
13 examination site per county and for online examinations for licensure.
