1 **Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine as follows:**

2 **Sec. 1. 12 MRSA §6682** is enacted to read:

3 **§6682. Fines**

4 A fine collected pursuant to a violation of this subchapter pertaining to soft-shelled
5 clams must be paid to the municipality in which the violation occurred.

6 **SUMMARY**

7 This bill requires that a fine collected for a violation of soft-shelled clam laws be paid
8 to the municipality in which the violation occurred.
