4 5	A fine collected pursuant to a violation of this subchapter pertaining to soft-shelled clams must be paid to the municipality in which the violation occurred.

7 8	This bill requires that a fine collected for a violation of soft-shelled clam laws be paid to the municipality in which the violation occurred.
