5 **Sec. 2. 29-A MRSA §523, sub-§5, ¶U**, as enacted by PL 2005, c. 433, §9 and  
6 affected by §28, is amended to read:

7 U. Afghanistan Campaign Medal; ~~;~~ and

8 **Sec. 3. 29-A MRSA §523, sub-§5, ¶V** is enacted to read:

9 V. Combat Infantryman Badge.

10 **SUMMARY**

11 This bill adds the Combat Infantryman Badge, established by the War Department in  
12 1943 to recognize the skill and heroism of the American infantry, to the list of special  
13 commemorative decals for sets of special veterans registration plates.
