1	Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine as follows:
2	Sec. 1. 10 MRSA c. 228 is enacted to read:
3	CHAPTER 228
4	CELLULAR TELEPHONES
5	§1500-G. Charges for lost cellular telephone
6	A wireless telecommunications provider may not charge more than \$50 in wireless
7	telephone service charges for a lost or stolen cellular telephone after the telephone has
8	been reported lost or stolen. For purposes of this section, "wireless telephone service" has
9	the same meaning as in section 1496-B, subsection 4 and "wireless telecommunications
0	provider" has the same meaning as in section 1496-B, subsection 5.
1	SUMMARY
12	This bill prohibits a wireless telecommunications provider from charging more than
13	\$50 in wireless telephone service charges for a lost or stolen cellular telephone after the
14	telephone has been reported lost or stolen.
