In addition, this amendment transfers funds from the Budget Stabilization Fund to the unappropriated surplus of the General Fund to cover the additional General Fund expenses resulting from the shift in funding percentages for the State Police program. A balanced General Fund budget is maintained for the 2008-2009 biennium.
