SENATE AMENDMENT "B" to COMMITTEE AMENDMENT "A" to H.P. 383,
L.D. 499, Bill, "An Act Making Unified Appropriations and Allocations for the
Expenditures of State Government, General Fund and Other Funds, and Changing Certain
Provisions of the Law Necessary to the Proper Operations of State Government for the
Fiscal Years Ending June 30, 2008 and June 30, 2009"

Amend the amendment in Part XXXX in section 13 by adding after §1512 the
following:

§1513. Voluntary municipal contributions

Any municipality may voluntarily contribute extra funds to the support of any school
within the regional school unit and may designate the services to be supported by such
funds.'

Amend the amendment by relettering or renumbering any nonconsecutive Part letter
or section number to read consecutively.

SUMMARY

This amendment permits a municipality to voluntarily contribute to the support of
any school and designate services to be supported by the contribution.
