

SENATE AMENDMENT "D" to COMMITTEE AMENDMENT "A" to H.P. 383, L.D. 499, Bill, "An Act Making Unified Appropriations and Allocations for the Expenditures of State Government, General Fund and Other Funds, and Changing Certain Provisions of the Law Necessary to the Proper Operations of State Government for the Fiscal Years Ending June 30, 2008 and June 30, 2009"

Amend the amendment in Part XXXX in section 13 in §1486 in subsection 1 in the first paragraph in the last line (page 774, line 8 in amendment) by inserting after the following: "meeting" the following: 'if the proposed budget exceeds 105% of the total amount projected for essential programs and services'

Under this amendment, the budget validation process is required only if the proposed budget exceeds 105% of the total amount projected for essential programs and services.
