8 SENATE AMENDMENT "I" to COMMITTEE AMENDMENT "A" to H.P. 383,
9 L.D. 499, Bill, "An Act Making Unified Appropriations and Allocations for the
10 Expenditures of State Government, General Fund and Other Funds, and Changing Certain
11 Provisions of the Law Necessary to the Proper Operations of State Government for the
12 Fiscal Years Ending June 30, 2008 and June 30, 2009"

13 Amend the amendment in Part XXXX by inserting after section 46 the following:

14 'Sec. XXXX-47. Exemption for Hancock County; school year 2007-2008. 15 Notwithstanding any provision of this Part to the contrary, Hancock County is exempt from the regional school unit formation requirements and is not subject to the reductions 16 17 in allocations for system administration as specified in the Maine Revised Statutes, Title 20-A, section 15680, subsection 1, paragraph A, for operation and maintenance of plant 18 19 as specified in Title 20-A, section 15680, subsection 1, paragraph B, for special education 20 costs as specified in Title 20-A, section 15681-A, subsection 2-A and for transportation 21 costs as specified in Title 20-A, section 15681-A, subsection 3-A.

22 Sec. XXXX-48. Implementing legislation. No later than January 8, 2008, the 23 Commissioner of Education shall submit legislation to the Joint Standing Committee on 24 Education and Cultural Affairs that exempts Hancock County from the regional school 25 unit formation requirements and the reductions in allocations for system administration as 26 specified in the Maine Revised Statutes, Title 20-A, section 15680, subsection 1, 27 paragraph A, for operation and maintenance of plant as specified in Title 20-A, section 28 15680, subsection 1, paragraph B, for special education costs as specified in Title 20-A, 29 section 15681-A, subsection 2-A and for transportation costs as specified in Title 20-A, 30 section 15681-A, subsection 3-A. The committee shall submit emergency legislation 31 based on the commissioner's legislation to the Second Regular Session of the 123rd 32 Legislature that implements the exemption of Hancock County for school years 33 beginning on or after July 1, 2008.'

34 Amend the amendment by relettering or renumbering any nonconsecutive Part letter 35 or section number to read consecutively.

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SUMMARY

2 This amendment exempts Hancock County from the regionalization requirements and 3 the decreases in funding for administration, special education, maintenance and 4 transportation costs for the 2007-2008 school year.

5 The commissioner is required to submit legislation that implements the exemption for 6 Hancock County.
