SENATE AMENDMENT "K" to COMMITTEE AMENDMENT "A" to H.P. 383, L.D. 499, Bill, "An Act Making Unified Appropriations and Allocations for the Expenditures of State Government, General Fund and Other Funds, and Changing Certain Provisions of the Law Necessary to the Proper Operations of State Government for the Fiscal Years Ending June 30, 2008 and June 30, 2009"

Amend the amendment in Part XXXX by inserting after section 46 the following:

'Sec. XXXX-47. Calculation of reductions. In calculating reductions pursuant to the Maine Revised Statutes, Title 20-A, section 15680, subsection 1, paragraphs A and B and section 15681-A, subsections 2-A and 3-A, the Commissioner of Education may not calculate the reductions based on a school administrative unit's essential programs and services expenditures but shall instead calculate the reductions based on a school administrative unit's essential programs and services allocations.'

Amend the amendment by relettering or renumbering any nonconsecutive Part letter or section number to read consecutively.

SUMMARY

This amendment specifies that, in calculating reductions pursuant to the Maine Revised Statutes, Title 20-A, section 15680, subsection 1, paragraphs A and B and section 15681-A, subsections 2-A and 3-A, the Commissioner of Education may not calculate the reductions based on a school administrative unit's essential programs and services expenditures but shall instead calculate the reductions based on a school administrative unit's essential programs and services allocations.
