#### SENATE AMENDMENT " / " to COMMITTEE AMENDMENT "A" to H.P. 383, L.D. 499

#### SUMMARY

This amendment exempts from the regionalization requirements and the penalties for nonconforming school administrative units for the 2007-2008 school year efficient districts, which are defined as school districts that have reported 2005-2006 per-pupil expenditures for system administration that represent less than 4% of its total per-pupil expenditures.

7 The Commissioner of Education is required to adopt major substantive rules that 8 establish criteria for identifying efficient districts, beginning with the 2008-2009 school 9 year. The commissioner is also required to submit legislation that implements the 10 exemptions for efficient school districts.
