## 1 Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine as follows:

2 Sec. 1. 14 MRSA §755 is enacted to read:

## 3 §755. Unlawful sexual contact

4 <u>An action based upon a complaint of unlawful sexual contact may be commenced at</u> 5 <u>any time. For purposes of this section, "unlawful sexual contact" has the same meaning</u> 6 <u>as delineated in Title 17-A, section 255-A.</u>

- 8 This bill removes the statute of limitations for a civil action based upon the complaint 9 of unlawful sexual contact.
