## An Act To Make More Affordable the Surcharge on the Sale of Dogs and Cats That Have Not Been Neutered

### 1 Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine as follows:

Sec. 1. 7 MRSA §3933, sub-§4, as enacted by PL 2005, c. 281, §7, is amended to
read:

4 **4.** Surcharge on sale of dogs and cats that have not been neutered. A person 5 maintaining a pet shop shall collect a surcharge of \$25 \$5 on each cat or dog sold that has 6 not been neutered and forward the entire surcharge to the department for deposit in the 7 Companion Animal Sterilization Fund established under section 3910-B.

#### **SUMMARY**

9 This bill reduces the surcharge collected by pet shops on each dog or cat sold that has 10 not been neutered from \$25 to \$5.
