1 Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine as follows:

2 Sec. 1. 13 MRSA §1035 is amended to read:

3 §1035. Penalties

32

4 Whoever Except for violations of section 1371-A, a person who fails to comply with 5 or violates any of the provisions of this chapter in respect to the establishment, 6 maintenance or operation of a cemetery, community mausoleum, crematory or 7 columbarium, or to the disposal of dead human bodies shall is subject, unless another 8 penalty is provided under this chapter, be punished by to a fine of not less than \$100 nor 9 more than \$500, or by to imprisonment for not more than 6 months, or by to both. A 10 violation of section 1371-A is a civil violation punishable by a fine of not less than \$100 11 nor more than \$500.

SUMMARY

This bill specifies that a violation of the statutory limitations on construction and excavation near burial sites is a civil violation punishable only by fine. This provision is enforceable by municipalities.
