#### **Fiscal Detail and Notes**

Exempting from the state income tax certain military retitrement benefits will reduce General Fund revenue by an estimated \$287,187 in fiscal year 2007-08 and \$382,916 in fiscal year 2008-09. This bill also includes a one-time General Fund appropriation of \$11,000 in fiscal year 2007-08 for Maine Revenue Services' computer programming costs.
