**Resolve, To Reduce the Size of State Government by Four Percent**

Resolved: That each state department shall evaluate its operations 3 to determine if any of its programs or personnel could be reduced by 4%. When 4 conducting this evaluation, each department shall consider reducing those programs or 5 personnel, including those employees eligible for retirement, the reduction of which 6 would have the least impact on the ability of the department to complete its mission. Each department shall report the results of its evaluation and any potential cost savings to 7 the Commissioner of Administrative and Financial Services by December 15, 2007. 8

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## **SUMMARY**

10 This resolve directs each state department to conduct an evaluation of its operations 11 to determine if any of its programs and personnel could be reduced by 4% without 12 affecting the ability of the department to complete its mission. Each department shall 13 report the results of its evaluation and any potential cost savings to the Commissioner of 14 Administrative and Financial Services by December 15, 2007.
