1 Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine as follows:

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2 Sec. 1. 36 MRSA §5122, sub-§2, ¶Y is enacted to read:

Y. To the extent included in federal adjusted gross income, an amount equal to the
deduction for a qualified conservation contribution allowed under the provisions of
Section 170 of the Code as of January 1, 2007 without regard to any federal
expiration dates that apply to that Section.

7 Sec. 2. Application date. This Act applies to tax years beginning on or after
8 January 1, 2007.

SUMMARY

- 10 This bill establishes an income tax deduction for contributions of conservation
- 11 easements that qualify for a federal charitable deduction. This deduction continues under
- 12 state law even if the federal deduction expires, as currently scheduled, at the end of 2007.
