1 **Sec. 1. Fall catch-and-release season established. Resolved:** That the
2 Commissioner of Inland Fisheries and Wildlife shall adopt rules to establish a catch-and-
3 release fishing season for the months of October and November in all stocked moving
4 waters of the State. Rules adopted pursuant to this section are routine technical rules as
5 defined in the Maine Revised Statutes, Title 5, chapter 375, subchapter 2-A.

6 SUMMARY

7 This resolve directs the Commissioner of Inland Fisheries and Wildlife to adopt rules
8 to establish a catch-and-release season in October and November for all stocked moving
9 waters of the State.
