COMMITTEE AMENDMENT "A" to H.P. 458, L.D. 591, Bill, "An Act Regarding Occupational Safety and Health Training for Workers on State-funded Construction Projects"

Amend the bill in section 1 in §1309-A in subsection 1 in the first line (page 1, line 5 in L.D.) by striking out the following: "a public work" and inserting the following: 'public works'

Amend the bill in section 1 in §1309-A in subsection 1 in the 2nd line (page 1, line 6 in L.D.) by striking out the following: "2008 and amounting to \$10,000" and inserting the following: '2009 and amounting to \$100,000'

SUMMARY

This amendment, which is the minority report of the Joint Standing Committee on Labor, clarifies that the employee training requirement imposed by the bill applies only to state public works and only to those works entered into on or after July 1, 2009. It also increases the amount of the contract from \$10,000 to \$100,000 as the minimum bid for the application of the training requirement.
