1 **Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine as follows:**

2 **Sec. 1. 22 MRSA §4064**, as amended by PL 1997, c. 39, §1, is repealed.

3 **SUMMARY**

4 This bill repeals the laws that give the Department of Health and Human Services
5 authority to place children in long-term foster care, either by agreement with the foster
6 parents or pursuant to a court order.
