1 **Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine as follows:**

2 **Sec. 1. 12 MRSA §11152, sub-§8** is enacted to read:

3 **8. Transfer of antlerless deer permit to a child with a disability.** A person who  
4 holds a valid antlerless deer permit may transfer that permit to a child with a physical  
5 disability who has successfully completed a hunter safety course acceptable under  
6 sections 10108 and 11105. The commissioner shall administer transfers under this  
7 subsection.

8 **SUMMARY**

9 This bill allows a person who holds a valid antlerless deer permit to transfer that  
10 permit to a child with a disability as long as the child has successfully completed a hunter  
11 safety course.
