2	Sec. 1. 12 MRSA §11152, sub-§8 is enacted to read:
3 4 5 6 7	8. Transfer of antlerless deer permit to a child with a disability. A person who holds a valid antlerless deer permit may transfer that permit to a child with a physical disability who has successfully completed a hunter safety course acceptable under sections 10108 and 11105. The commissioner shall administer transfers under this subsection.
