9 COMMITTEE AMENDMENT "A" to H.P. 469, L.D. 620, Bill, "An Act Relating  
10 to Liquor Samples"

11 Amend the bill in section 1 in §1504 by striking out all of subsection 5 (page 1, lines  
12 15 to 17 in L.D.) and inserting the following:

13 '5. Maximum sample. The maximum amount of samples of distilled spirits given  
14 to a retail licensee by a sales representative may not exceed 3 liters per year per distiller  
15 represented by that sales representative, and samples may not exceed one liter.'

16 SUMMARY

17 This amendment clarifies that the 3-liter-per-year limitation is per distiller  
18 represented by a sales representative. The amendment removes the provision that  
19 samples be provided in the smallest container size available for sale in this State and  
20 retains the provision that samples may not exceed one liter.
