1	Be it enacted by th	e People of the	State of Maine as:	follows:
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- Sec. 1. 29-A MRSA §1901, as enacted by PL 1993, c. 683, Pt. A, §2 and affected by Pt. B, §5, is amended to read:
- 4 §1901. General restriction
- A person may not use, sell or equip a vehicle with a lens, muffler, reflector, lighting device, window tinting material or other a vehicle with aftermarket equipment on a public way contrary to this Title or contrary to the rules of the Chief of the State Police.

8 SUMMARY

This bill amends the equipment laws for motor vehicles by removing the specific list of aftermarket equipment prohibited and removing the prohibition on the sale of or equipping a motor vehicle with aftermarket equipment, and limits the prohibition on use of a motor vehicle with aftermarket equipment to use on a public way.
