1 **Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine as follows:**

2 **Sec. 1. 12 MRSA §10501, sub-§9**, as amended by PL 2003, c. 511, §1 and
3 affected by §3 and c. 614, §§9 and 10, is repealed.

4 **SUMMARY**

5 Under current law possession of hunting equipment in the fields or forests or on the
6 waters or ice in the State on Sunday is considered prima facie evidence of a violation of
7 hunting on Sunday. This bill repeals that law.
