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2 Sec. 1. 5 MRSA §285, sub-§14 is enacted to read:

3 <u>14. Supplemental coverage; Medicare-eligible retirees.</u> For those retirees who are
4 eligible for coverage under this section and who are also eligible for Medicare, the State
5 shall pay 100% of the retirees' share of the premiums for Medicare Part B only.
6 SUMMARY

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7 This bill requires the State to pay Medicare Part B premiums for state retirees.
