1 **Sec. 1. Road project funding. Resolved:** That the Department of
2 Transportation shall authorize the release of the funds agreed upon in its memorandum of
3 agreement between the department and the Town of Houlton to share costs related to
4 preliminary engineering and improvement of a portion of Bangor Street, also known as
5 U.S. Route 2-A, from the junction of Military Street to the urban compact line and
6 Military Street from Kendall Street to Bangor Street as described in Federal Aid Project
7 Identification Number 9192.00.

8 **SUMMARY**

9 This resolve directs the Department of Transportation to authorize the release of the funds
10 needed to improve U.S. Route 2-A in Houlton as was agreed upon in a memorandum of
11 agreement between the town and the department.
