SUMMARY

2 This amendment is the majority report of the committee. This amendment changes 3 the resolve to include the Department of Professional and Financial Regulation in the 4 group of agencies directed to develop a plan for implementing the Maine Model Building 5 Code and the International Existing Building Code. It also includes a requirement that the agencies identify overlap between model codes and the codes and standards listed in 6 the Maine Revised Statutes, Title 10, section 9703 and the advantages and disadvantages 7 8 of maintaining the current state fire code or changing to the International Fire Code. It 9 also requires the agencies to identify measures that allow for preserving the artistic and 10 architectural integrity of historic structures without unreasonable risk to life and safety.
