### An Act To Limit Expenditures by Political Action Committees

1 **Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine as follows:**

2 **Sec. 1. 21-A MRS §1056, sub-§1**, as amended by PL 2001, c. 430, §10, is  
3 further amended to read:

4 **1. Aggregate expenditures.** A committee may not make contributions in support of  
5 or against the candidacy of one person aggregating more than \$500 in any election for a  
6 gubernatorial candidate, or \$250 in any election for any other candidate.

7 **SUMMARY**

8 Current law limits expenditures by political action committees in support of a  
9 candidate. This bill limits in the same amount expenditures by political action committees  
10 against a candidate.
