1	Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine as follows:
2	Sec. 1. 36 MRSA §4366-C, sub-§2-A is enacted to read:
3 4 5 6	2-A. Shipment only to licensed retailers. A distributor may not sell or offer to sell cigarettes to a retailer unless the retailer has provided documentation to the distributor that the retailer holds a current retail tobacco license issued under Title 22, section 1551-A.
7	SUMMARY
8 9 10	This bill requires a tobacco retailer to document a current retail tobacco license before a distributor can ship cigarettes to that retailer. This bill ensures all tobacco retailers are licensed in order to purchase cigarettes from distributors to be sold at retail.
