1 **Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine as follows:**

2 **Sec. 1. 36 MRSA §5122, sub-§2, ¶Y** is enacted to read:

3 Y. Income received by an individual for active duty in the Armed Forces of the
4 United States or as compensation for a disability as a veteran of the Armed Forces of
5 the United States.
